

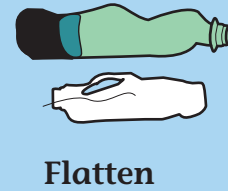
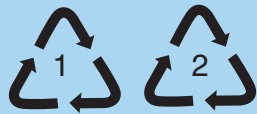
Recycle — It's Easy

Rinse

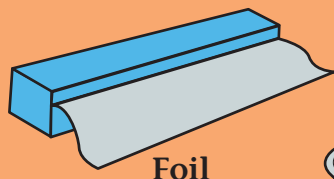
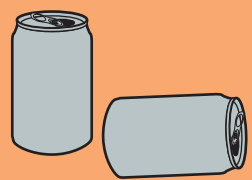


No need to remove labels

Cans & Glass

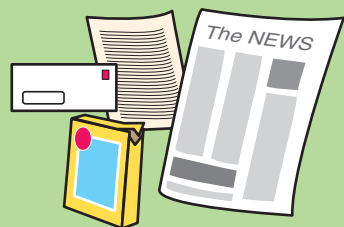
- Glass Bottles and Jars, all colors

Plastic Containers

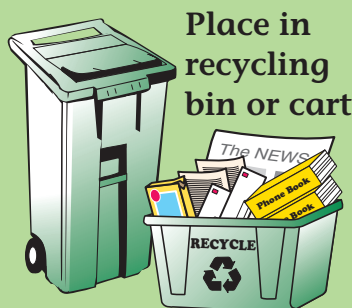
- PET #1 Plastic Bottles & Jars

- #3-#7 Bottles and Containers



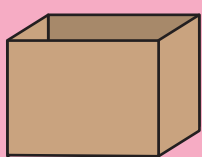
Mixed paper and newspaper



Bundle and tie newspaper

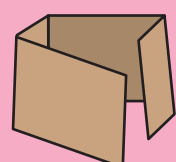


Corrugated cardboard
